



During its first year of execution, the Project Cenit SOSTAQUA has obtained encouraging results.

The Project SOSTAQUA directed by Grupo Agbar in close collaboration with CTM and which has the aim of contributing to the achievement of an urban cycle of autosustainable water, has already been in action for a year.

During this period of time, in which CTM has played an important part, the scientific basis for securing the success of the project for the following three years has been set. The first experimental results have already been obtained for the different points of research which form it: water, wastes, energy, health and environmental control.

We should bear in mind that numerous companies take part in the Project and that CTM collaborates closely with five of them, in particular with Grupo Agbar, Amphos XXI Consulting, CRIC, REMOSA and Solvay.

In the month of November CTM hosted a follow up meeting in which, among other issues, the developments in the technology of desalinating for the obtention of potable water were shown. This treatment constitutes an excellent technological option with which to tackle the problems of water supply which the country often suffers.
